

ABOUT HCCN

HFP's HCCN is a technical assistance program funded by HRSA that is open to Federally Qualified Health Centers and look-alikes across Pennsylvania. The goals are to support health centers to leverage health information technology and data to deliver high quality, culturally competent, equitable and comprehensive primary health care, with a specific focus on improvements in clinical quality, patient-centered care, and provider and staff well being.

PROJECT EXAMPLES

- » Individualized consultation and support for digital health tools (e.g. patient portals, and remote patient monitoring (RPM) products)
- » Planning and support for UDS+ submission
- » Privacy & security education and support
- » Consultation and coaching on NCQA Health Equity accreditation
- » Peer groups to support Care Management Leaders and Quality Improvement staff

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION

Health Centers in the HCCN have access to the expert staff team at HFP, as well as Subject Matter Experts in most EHRs. The HCCN subsidizes implementation of the population health management and data warehouse tool, Azara DRVS, and provides support for use of this software and other population health management tools. Expert and peer support groups and EHR user groups provide additional assistance for HCCN participants.
